Dear Mr. Thurston:

Re: Construction of Underwater Section of Outlet Pipe to Hawkesbury Lagoon

Thank you for your letter of 25th inst. confirming your previous verbal advice that it will be in order for CIP to proceed with the construction of the 480 foot underwater section of the outlet pipe to our Lagoon at Hawkesbury. As a result of your letter of authority, I have instructed our engineering people to proceed with said construction.

For your information, the work consists of building an underwater section of the existing outlet or outfall pipe to the Lagoon which presently extends just beyond the shore of Cobb's Island. Said underwater section will go into the channel of the Ottawa River, a distance of approximately 480 feet from the shore of Cobb's Island. A ditch in the channel bottom will be dug to receive the pipe, so that it can be backfilled and the pipe securely held in place. At those points where the depth of the River makes ditching impracticable, the pipe will be secured by concrete anchors. The pipe will be 54 inches in diameter and will have a 3/8 inch thick wall of polyester glass reinforced. The estimated cost of this work is \$64,000.00.

I would advise that Mr. J.P. Hamilton, of the Mason Foulds Arnup & Co. legal firm in Toronto, will follow this matter up with your Department's Toronto office in order to ascertain


