

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HAWKESBURY

By-law No. 76-91

Being a By-law prohibiting the posting up or distributing  
of posters, pictures or handbills.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 230 (1) 8 provides the Council of a municipality to pass by-laws for licensing, regulating and governing bill posters, advertising sign painters, bulletin board painters, sign posters and bill distributors, and for prohibiting the posting up or distributing of posters, pictures or handbills.

AND WHEREAS Council now deems it necessary and expedient to establish a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters to meet only the anticipated cost to the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hawkesbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. No bill distributor or other person shall distribute any handbill, circular, or other paper (other than a newspaper or magazine) within the municipality, by depositing the same in or upon motor vehicles parked or standing in any public place, or by handing the same to pedestrians or others on the highways of the Town.
2. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is subject to the penalty imposed in the Provincial Offences Act.
