Chers membres du conseil de police,

Notre détachement a connu une excellente saison estivale

Notre unité maritime a effectué plus de 700 vérifications d'embarcations et cumulé 143 heures de patrouille sur nos voies navigables. Notre unité auxiliaire s'est classée parmi les trois meilleures de la province en matière d'engagement communautaire, totalisant un impressionnant 741 heures en seulement trois mois — une réalisation remarquable dont nous sommes extrêmement fiers.

Notre unité des crimes a résolu la série d'incendies criminels visant des pizzerias dans la ville de Hawkesbury, ainsi que plusieurs dossiers d'agression sexuelle.

Je tiens également à souligner l'excellent travail de l'agent Eric Mantha pour son engagement dans l'initiative VTT en partenariat avec les gardes forestiers et le Club de VTT de l'Est ontarien. Il s'agit d'un excellent exemple de collaboration avec d'autres organismes afin d'améliorer la sécurité publique. L'agent Mantha demeure très actif au sein de la communauté dans son rôle d'agent de liaison pour les crimes haineux.

Je souhaite aussi féliciter l'agent Sébastien Houle et l'équipe du peloton A pour leur travail exemplaire lors d'un programme RIDE sur le pont, qui a mené à la saisie de plus de 24 000 \$ de marijuana illégale. Nos activités d'application des lois routières et nos patrouilles à vélo ont également augmenté de façon significative, particulièrement lors de la rentrée scolaire en septembre.

Je suis extrêmement fier d'être de retour au détachement de Hawkesbury depuis la fin juin, et j'ai hâte à notre rencontre du 28 novembre 2025.

Dear Members of the Police Board,

Our detachment had an excellent summer season, and I'm pleased to share some highlights from our teams.

Our Marine Unit conducted over 700 vessel checks and logged 143 hours on our waterways. Our Auxiliary Unit ranked top three in the province for community engagement, contributing an outstanding 741 hours in just three months—an incredible achievement and something we are extremely proud of. Our Crime Unit successfully resolved the series of pizza-related arson incidents in the City of Hawkesbury, as well as multiple sexual assault investigations.

I would also like to recognize PC Eric Mantha for his strong engagement with the ATV initiative in partnership with the Wardens and the ATV Club of Eastern Ontario. This is an excellent example of collaboration with external agencies to enhance public safety. PC Mantha continues to be highly active in the community in his role as our Hate Crime Liaison Officer.

Additionally, PC Sébastien Houle and A Platoon are to be commended for their teamwork during a RIDE program on the bridge, which resulted in the seizure of over \$24,000 in illegal marijuana. Our traffic enforcement and bicycle patrols also increased significantly, especially with the return to school in September.

I am extremely proud to be back at the Hawkesbury Detachment since the end of June, and I look forward to our upcoming meeting on November 28, 2025.
